

## IWWF Placement Ranking

The concept is to rank skiers based on how they place in tournaments considering the type of tournament and level of competition. This is for Open ranking only.

Points will be given to each place based on the following factors:

### 1. Placement Points

A fixed table of points starting at 1000 points for 1<sup>st</sup> place and each succeeding place will be 91% of the of the preceding place.

### 2. A tournament type coefficient. The chart is as follows:

3. A skier value coefficient reflecting the competition present at the tournament.

This coefficient is calculated from the individual competitor's attendance in relation to their previous year's ranked position. Different levels of competitors will give a different competitor coefficient as per the following table:-

Number of competitors entered in the competition classified in the first 15 places of the previous year's Ranking List	4 or more	1
Number of competitors entered in the competition classified in the first 30 places of the previous year's Ranking List	9 or more	0.85
Number of competitors entered in the competition classified in the first 60 places of the previous year's Ranking List	15 or more	0.70

If the number of competitors entered in the competition classified in the first 60 places of the previous year's Ranking List is lower than 15 then the following table would apply:-

The final points assigned will be the following formula:  
(Placement Points)x(Tournament Type Coefficient)x(Skier Value Coefficient)

Each skier's ranking will be based on the sum of the best 5 placement point scores.

Additionally, there is a further factor in considering the tournament type. Two basic types of tournaments will be considered.

#### Type 1

This is a tournament where only Open division is held. This would encompass Elite tournaments, cash prize tournaments, World and Region Championships. In this case the scorebook placement will be used.

#### Type 2

This is a multi division tournament. In this case all scores achieved, using each skiers best score, will be used and placed from highest to lowest to assign placements. In slalom, only scores at 58kmph for men and 55 kmph for women will be used.
